Dear Consultee

In line with the requirements of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and School Organisation Code 2018, we are writing to inform you about the Decision Notice issued in connection with the following proposal.

On 7th April 2021, Caerphilly County Borough Council's Cabinet agreed the proposal to expand **Trinity Fields Special School and Resource Centre** via a new building extension and outdoor play space to accommodate an additional 80 pupils.

The Cabinet considered the proposal, the statutory objections submitted, the Local Authority response and the recommendations of the Education Scrutiny Committee held on the 22nd March 2021.

It was noted that there were 238 statutory objections received. The concerns raised are summarised in the Objection Report together with the responses from the Local Authority.

Referral of local authority decisions to the Welsh Ministers

- A trust holding property on behalf of a voluntary or foundation school subject to the proposal; and
- A further education institution affected by the proposal.
