Budget 2020/2021



Dear resident

It is my responsibility to set the policing element of your council tax.

This is one of the most important decisions I make each year and I must balance the Chief Constable's financial requirements for operational policing with affordability for local tax payers.

In determining the budget for 2020/21, I have taken into account a financial case put forward by the Chief Constable of Gwent Police, and a recommendation from the Gwent Police and Crime Panel to keep costs down

for residents.

My team also carried out an extensive 13 week engagement programme across Gwent to ensure that as many people as possible had an opportunity to share their views.

More than 66 per cent of respondents indicated they were content to support a council tax rise of up to £2 per month.

Taking all of these factors into account I have decided to increase the precept by 6.82 per cent, which will mean that the average household in Gwent (band D properties) will pay £1.45 extra per

month for its policing service. I am pleased that I have been able to keep the figure below £1.50.

I am reassured that the extra funding will allow Gwent Police to continue to invest in priority areas such as neighbourhood policing, child protection, domestic abuse, rape and sexual assault, hate crime, and serious and organised crime. It will also allow for continued investment in Gwent Police's recruitment programme, which has seen more than 400 new officers and 160 new posts created over the last three years. This will also provide a solid

foundation for the further recruitment of about 165 officers from the government's Operation Uplift programme, which will recruit an extra 20,000 officers across the UK.

I would like to thank everyone that took the time to share their views and to the Police and Crime Panel for their continued scrutiny and support.

Fy nghyfrifoldeb i yw pennu elfen plismona treth y cyngor.

Mae hwn yn un o'r penderfyniadau pwysicaf rwy'n eu gwneud bob blwyddyn a rhaid i mi gydbwysgo gofynion ariannol y Prif Gwnstabl ar gyfer plismona gweithredol gyda fforddiadwyedd i drethdalwyr lleol.

Wrth bennu'r gyllideb ar gyfer 2020/21 rwyf wedi ystyried achos ariannol a gyflwynwyd gan Brif Gwnstabl Heddlu Gwent, ac argymhelliaid gan Banel Heddlu a Thro seddu Gwent i gadw costau i lawr i

breswylwyr. Cynhaliodd fy nhîm raglen helaeth o ymgysylltu ledled Gwent am 13 wythnos hefyd i sicrhau bod cymaint o bobl â phosibl wedi cael cyfle i rannu eu barn.

Nododd dros 66 y cant o'r bobl a ymatebodd eu bod yn fodlon cefnogi codiad yn nhreth y cyngor o hyd at £2 y mis.

Gan ystyried yr holl ffactorau hyn rwyf wedi penderfynu cynyddu'r praecept 6.82 y cant a fydd yn golygu y bydd cartref cyffredin yng Ngwent (eiddo band D) yn talu £1.45 ychwanegol y mis am ei wasanaeth plismona. Rwy'n falch fy

mod wedi gallu cadw'r ffigwr dan £1.50.

Rwyf yn dawel fy meddwl y bydd y cyllid ychwanegol yn galluogi Heddlu Gwent i barhau i fuddsoddi mewn meysydd sy'n cael blaenoriaeth fel plismona cymdoagaeth, amddiffyn plant, cam-drin domestig, treisio, ymosodiadau rhywiol, troseddu casineb, a thro seddu difrifol a chyfundrefnol. Bydd hefyd yn galluogi Heddlu Gwent i barhau i fuddsoddi yn ei raglen recriwtio, sydd wedi sicrhau dros 400 o swyddogion newydd a 160 o swyddi newydd dros y tair blynedd diwethaf.

Bydd hefyd yn sail gadarn ar gyfer recriwtio tua 165 o swyddogion trwy Ymgyrch Uplift y Llywodraeth a fydd yn recriwtio 20,000 ychwanegol o swyddogion ar draws y DU.

Hoffwn ddiolch i bawb a roddodd o'u hamser i rannu eu barn ac i'r Panel Heddlu a Thro seddu am ei waith craffu a'i gefnogaeth barhaus.
