How we will use your information

Purpose and legal basis for using your information

Purpose of processing

We will use the information you provide to administer the Older Road Users - Road Safety Training Scheme and provide the training. The older road users road safety training course is provided by Road Safety staff and partners who deliver presentations aimed at educating and encouraging safe driving practices. The project also provides an experience of driving a car with an Approved Driving Instructor who advises the driver. Participants register to take part and complete a questionnaire about their experience during the training.

Legal basis for processing

In order for the processing of personal data to be lawful under the General Data Protection Regulations 2016, a valid condition from Article 6 of the Regulations must be identified, which is outlined below:

Article 6(1)f. processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data, in particular where the data subject is a child.

The 1988 Road Road Traffic Act, Section 39, puts a "statutory duty" on the local authority to undertake studies into road traffic collisions, and to take steps both to reduce and prevent them.

If the information you provide is subject to such a request, where possible Caerphilly County Borough Council will consult with you on its release. If you object to the release of your information we will withhold your information if the relevant legislation allows.

How long will we retain your information

Details of retention period

How long Caerphilly County Borough Council retains information is determined through statutory requirements or best practice.

The paper records including the personal information we have collected will be held for a period of 3 years after which time it is destroyed.
