Caniatáu traffig unffordd yn unig ar hyd y lôn y tu ôl i dai rhif 50 i 12 Commercial Street, Aberbargod, i gyfeiriad y gogledd o'r gyffordd â Heol Ysgol Newydd i'r gyffordd â Stryd yr Ysgol.

Bydd y Gorchymyn arbrofol am gyfnod o ddeunaw mis o 1 Medi 2020 ac, yn ystod y cyfnod hwnnw, bydd y Cyngor yn ystyried a fydd darpariaethau'r Gorchymyn hwn yn parhau i fod mewn grym am gyfnod amhenodol, a gall y Pennaeth Isadeiledd, gan weithredu ar ran y Cyngor, wneud unrhyw newidiadau perthnasol yn ôl yr angen, am resymau diogelwch, neu derfynu'r arbrwf os bydd angen gwneud hynny, yn ei farn ef, o fewn y chwe mis cyntaf.

Commercial Street Rear Lanes, Aberbargoed - Experimental One-Way Traffic Order 2020.

NOTICE is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make the above order, the effect of which will be to:

Allow one-way traffic only along the lane to the rear of house numbers 52 to 66 Commercial Street, Aberbargoed in a southerly then easterly direction from its junction with Heol Ysgol Newydd to its junction with Commercial Street immediately south of house number 66 Commercial Street.

Allow one-way traffic only along the lane to the rear of house numbers 50 to 12 Commercial Street, Aberbargoed in a northerly direction from its junction with Heol Ysgol Newydd to its junction with the School Street.

The experimental Order will be for a period of eighteen months from 1st September 2020 during which time the Council is to consider whether the provisions of this Order shall continue in force indefinitely and the Head of Infrastructure acting on behalf of the Council may make any relevant changes as necessary, on safety grounds, or terminate the experiment if, in his opinion, the need arises within the first six months.
