The move to flexible and agile working models since the pandemic and, now supported by new polices to further embed the models, has meant less need for staff to travel to office locations. The ability to work closer to home, or alternative locations, and the technology to allow remote meetings and work collaboratively has meant less travelling across the county borough. Because of the changed working practices budgets which had previously been used for staff travel are no longer required and can be offered as savings.
