Please provide a brief description of how the saving will be achieved:

There are a number of tennis courts across the county borough, which are available for general use by the public. Following recent investment by the Council at both The Showfield, Blackwood and Ystrad Mynach Park, Tennis Wales has agreed to invest (match fund), at no cost to the Council (resurfacing, painting etc) in four additional sites (Rhymney, Morgan Jones Park, Pontymister and Ynysddu) to increase and promote participation in the sport. Subsequently, these sites will then be fitted with an 'E' gate, members of the public can book a court via an app on their smart phone, pay and they will be provided with a unique code to enter on the keypad on the entrance gate. This system will be able to provide usage figures and monitor the last users should any damage or issues be subsequently reported.

The fees suggested by Tennis Wales are: -

- o Family subscription £39.00 per year;
- Student subscription £19.00 per year;
- o Pay & play £4.50 per hour.

Based on this system being in operation in other neighbouring local authorities, Tennis Wales have been able to provide some potential additional income figures which are the basis of this savings proposal.
