## Please provide a brief description of how the saving will be achieved:

This proposal will be achieved by increasing the current scale of charges for use of sports pitches by 12%, the is a reduction on the original proposed increase of 20% and has been amended as a result of the budget consultation (the outturn for 2021/22 was £78,000). Currently the service is significantly subsidised, and our fees are less than those charged by many of our neighbouring local authorities.

The attached document sets out details of the current and proposed fees, the largest increase being £6.66 for a senior cricket fixture.
