There are substantive developments in early years that have increased the grants potential. As such officer posts will be considered for core or grant funding relevance as well as maximising the efficiency of resources through use of technologies and alternate ways to deliver provision. The grants will be maximised offering a temporary saving to the core Revenue Support Grant (RSG) funding in 2023-24.

The grant funding is for early intervention to tackle the impacts of poverty and disadvantage on the most vulnerable families. While there is much development and need for recruitment, the cover for delivery will be needed from core funded officer posts which can maximise the use of grant in the short term. In addition there are savings through use of technology and efficiencies in delivery. However, when there is steady state delivery within the grants there are unlikely to be the savings in core funding.

Early Years has a main focus on prevention, but the temporary savings proposed will not affect preventative delivery. If this were to become permanent savings, then there would be an impact on delivery of prevention services.
